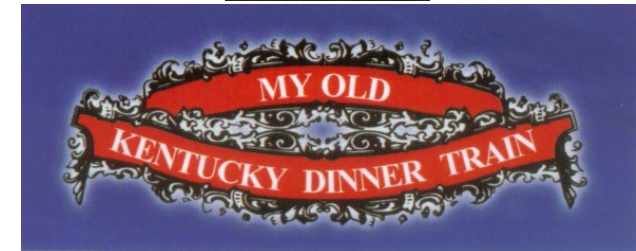

## My Old Kentucky Dinner Train Overview

An era when elegant dining cars offered a place to enjoy relaxed conversation, fine cuisine and gracious service against a ever changing backdrop. The trip is a 37 mile round trip. It will take about 2 1/2 hrs. to complete.



### Kentucky Railway Museum

In New Haven, KY you will find the Kentucky Railway Museum home of L&N 152. Built in 1905, L&N 152 was at the head of passenger trains on these rails. The L&N's Lebanon Branch, was a major artery through Central Kentucky. This living museum has a great example of steam and diesel locomotives. One of those diesel locomotives is MONON 32. This is BL-2 Locomotive built by EMC/EMD in 1948. It was one of 59 built for branch line operation. It is now one of seven in existence and one of three in regular service. The museum also has a dining car exhibit, a handcar, steam locomotive whistles, and much more. The Museum in conjunction with Family Modular Lines, operates a large model train exhibit building.

## Trip Overview

### Day 1

We will travel to Maker's Mark where we will have a tour of the distillery. Then we will travel to Bardstown to have lunch at The Old Stable Restaurant and time to walk and shop in the historical town of Bardstown, KY. We will check into the hotel and freshen up before our 5:00 p.m. ride on My Old Kentucky Dinner Train for a great dinner and train ride.

### Day 2

We start our day by eating breakfast at the hotel. Then we will board the motorcoach and travel to the Kentucky Railway Museum for a boxed lunch then we will take a ride behind steam locomotive L&N 152 on a 90 min round trip. After our train ride we will start our trip home about 4:00 P.M. We will stop on the way home for dinner on your own.
